All my other articles of silver or plated goods or hardware of any sort glass china crockery linen wine or household stores of any description I leave to my cousin Alicia M Losh

[I leave] to my cousin James Losh the paintings books & furniture [in] the breakfast room & dining room (except those otherwise named) also the large painting in the old staircase 2 large landscapes in the study & the portrait of the writer Holcraft - Also all articles in the north and south entrances but not in the intermediate ones - also the furniture of the best north bed room & dressing room & the 2 balcony rooms & dressing rooms and 2 rooms over the kitchen & all the servants bedrooms kitchen store parlour servants Hall laundry wash house stables barn & coach house - also all out of doors stock on the premises - all other things whether furniture pictures prints books & miscellaneous articles in all other rooms passages chests & closets with all articles writings drawings of my own I leave to my cousin Alicia M Losh - I except only the oak desk in the bathroom & the iron chest both which contain papers & memoranda belonging [to] the estate & these must go along with it - and I constitute my cousin James Losh my principal heir and residuary legatee.

Signed sealed & delivered this twenty third day of December A.D. 1851 in the presence of us who have in the presence of each other hereunto set our hands & seals.
